Traditional camp continues to provide a classic camp experience for all ages. This year, various programs were added for 7-8 year old campers to expand our offerings to even more young people.

Adventure programs continue to fill-up with five different camps offered; Trailblazers (ages 7-8), Pathfinders (ages 8-10), two sessions of Navigators (ages 11-13), and Challenge Camp (ages 14-16). Each camp experienced nature and adventure programming at their own level. Trailblazers slept in a tent outside the cabins, while Challenge Camp roughed it all week at Pioneer Field.

REGISTRATIONS

Aldersgate hosted over 1150 weeks of camp this summer!

Day Camp numbers have steadily grown over the past few years, especially after returning from COVID. We expect continued growth at Day Camp and are planning future upgrades to continue to grow day camp programs.

Overnight registrations were up almost 40%, returning to pre-COVID numbers. We expect registrations to continue this trend and look forward to busy summers coming up!







CAMPERSHIPS

Aldersgate, and our partners, awarded nearly \$12,000 in campership support this summer.

Aldersgate remains committed to providing camp experiences for campers who would not normally be able to attend camp due to financial restrictions.

To further this mission, Aldersgate partners with many United Methodist churches that provide scholarships for children and youth from their congregations to attend Aldersgate camps.

The year, Aldersgate maintained our relationship with Angel Tree Camping, a ministry that provides camp experiences for children and youth with an incarcerated parent. These campers are able to attend camp at no cost to their family and encounter a sacred space that empowers them to grow in faith and friendship.
